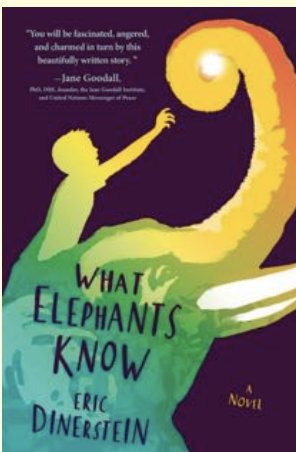
SKY CHASERS

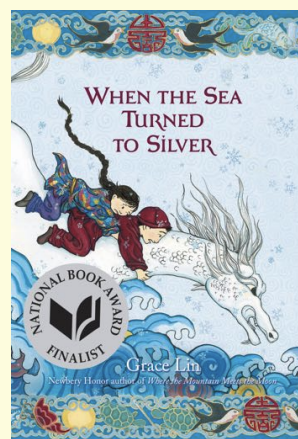
REFUGEE

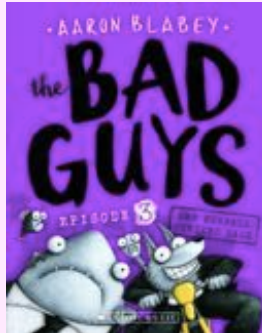
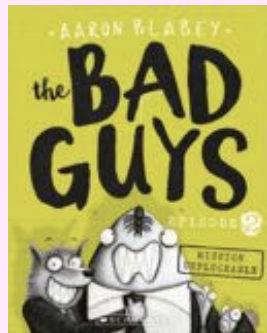
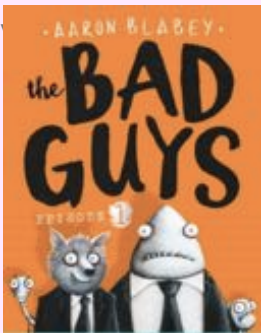
The Little Singapore Book will introduce readers to Singapore's history and culture through simple storytelling language, vivid illustrations packed with detail and a fresh perspective.

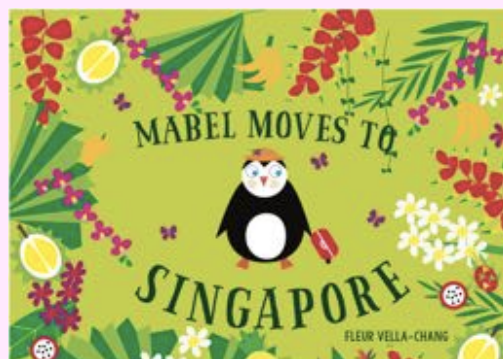
HELLO GOODBYE LITTLE ISLAND

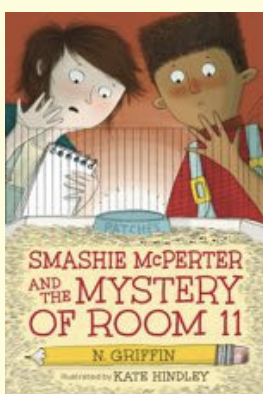
FOR THE RECORD

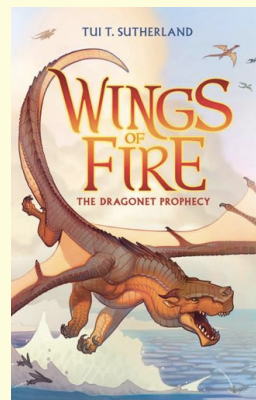
SMASHIE MCPETTER AND THE MYSTERY OF ROOM 11
