PAW PRINTS SERIES


Sarah Mounsey | \$ 12 each, \$ 30 for a set of three books









GROWING UP IN KAMPONG POTONG PASIR losephine Chia \$ 15




THE HOUSE ON PALMER ROAD | \$ 12 THE HOUSE ON SILAT ROAD | \$ 14



Nibbles the Book-Eating Monster has chomped his way into this book of dangerous dinosaurs. Has he bitten off more than he can chew?




OCEAN MEETS SKY


Finn's grandfather is gone now but Finn knows the perfect way to honor him. He'll build his own ship and sail out to find this magical place himself!

SUPERTATO: VEGGIES IN THE VALLEY OF DOOM Sue Hendra | \$ 14.50



MR PENGUIN AND THE LOST **TREASURE**




HELLO, UNIVERSE Erin Entrada Kelly

SONG FOR A WHALE Lynne Kelly | \$ 14.50







EMBASSY OF THE DEAD Will Mabbitt | \$ 14


When Jake opens a strange box containing
