The Year It All Ended

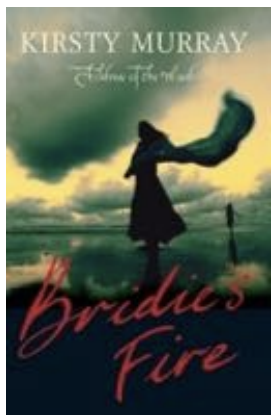

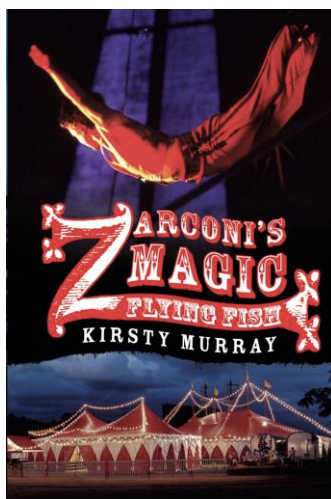

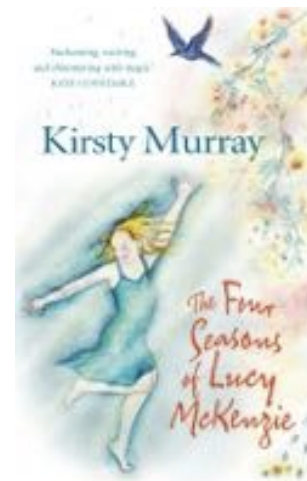


Zarconi's Magic Flying Fish
